**Subject:** Procedure for preparation of selection lists for admission to students in courses in subject university academic departments, affiliated and managed colleges.

**Sir,**

In accordance with the guidelines issued by the University Grants Association, New Delhi and the Department of Higher and Technical Education, Maharashtra State, the following procedure is being prescribed regarding the preparation of selection lists and waiting lists of students taking admission in various courses in the academic department, affiliated and managed colleges of the university.

1. First of all merit/mark wise list of all eligible students (including Gaga category students) applied for admission should be prepared. Since 50 per cent of the total district capacity of students are eligible for admission through open category, 50 per cent of the admission capacity. The students should be included in the selection list first if the students belonging to backward category are included in the merit list of the above open category, they should not be included in the list prepared for the backward category after giving admission from the open category.
2. A category-wise selection list should be prepared according to the following percentage of backward category students who have obtained merit / coefficient below the names of backward category students included in the above open category list and admission should be given accordingly.

3. According to the circular/decision issued by the government and the university from time to time, the students in the categories of disabled, children of active servicemen (active healthy services)/employees and ex-servicemen and sportspersons should be given Horizontal reservation from the open or reserved seats in the civil category according to their percentage.
4. After the admission process as per merit list, if any of the seats reserved for any Backward Class remain vacant, the process of allotment of seats to Special Backward Class (S.B.C.) candidates up to 2 percent of the total admission capacity shall be carried out on the basis of merit.
5. As above, in spite of allotting up to 2 percent Special Backward Class candidates, if sufficient candidates are not available in the prescribed percentage in the Backward Class category indicated in paragraph 2, then the Backward Class candidates should be filled from other categories on the basis of merit under the following groups on the principle of inter-changeability.  
Group A i) Scheduled caste (SC)  
ii) Scheduled Tribes (ST)  
Group B i) Free caste ( VJ-a)  
ii) Nomadic Tribes (b)  
Group C i) Nomadic Tribes (c)  
ii) Nomadic Tribes (d)  
iii) Other Backward Classes
6. Since it is necessary to admit women in 30 percent of the total admission capacity, care should be taken to ensure that women get admission in 30 percent of the seats in open and all reserved categories.
7. According to the order of the Hon.Vice Chancellor, from the academic session 2002-2003, the above process should be followed and the regional process should be completed.
