

Our College participated in the eradication of elephantiasis disease from the society



## 1. Doorstep Teaching

Objectives: The students of our College are regularly going to teach the primary and secondary school level students to nearly located area known as "Wadhar Vasti" at Bramhani village which is a very economically as well as academically poor. Their parents cannot educate them due to poverty. The tribe "Wadhar" is very economically poor in the society. Their earning source is based on daily work. Even the school going boys and girls are often going to daily wedges.

Our College has taken a step to learn them through our students of B. Sc. I, II and III year after their classes and practical's are over once in a week free of costs. Our students guided them and their parents and explains the importance of education and asks for learn.

**Outcomes:** Near about 50 children were benefitted. Near about 25 families got awareness about the importance of education in their lives.

## 2. Waste Management

Aim: The waste management awareness in the rural society.

Objectives: Under Swachha Bharat Program (Govt of India), the <u>CLEAN INDIA CAMPAIGN</u> was organized and conducted by physics department of the college on 1 march 2020. This campaign was focused on the waste management theme under the title *AWARENESS IN RURAL SOCIETY* - "Management of Daily Waste, Useful Goods and Useless Things". Students satisfied the villageres that how the family member should manage the daily waste, useful goods and useless things. How pesticides, fertilizers should manage and balance, why the e- waste like mobiles, batteries, chargers, radio receivers and T V sets should not be dumbed in house?, if they are useless then how these things may hazardous radioactively and chemically? We can neither thrown up them nor can fired. Our students tried well to convey the message to rural society through this campeign. In this situation good help was get to us by local administration such as Grampanchayat, Nagarparishad etc. In this regard our students called the metting with Sarpanch and some villageres. The outcome of the metting was very nice. The colaborative work with our students was committed by village authorities. They decided and committed to collect the polymer- plastic-rubber waste, cemical waste, poisonous waste, electronic waste and electrical waste separately, once in six months from the villageres and shopes.

**Outcomes:** Total 55 students were participated, and campaigned in nearby six villages i. e. Mohpa, Deobardi, Mhasepathar, Khumari, Mandawi, and Mohgaon in the Kalmeshwar tahasil. Total 505 families were covered by the students through the whole day.

# 3. Sericulture and Apiculture Technology For Farmers

Aim: Awareness about 'Sericulture & Apiculture Techniques' for business point of view.

## **Objectives:**

One day workshop on 'Sericulture & Apiculture Techniques' was organized at K.Z.S. Science college, Bramhani, Kalameshwar in collaboration with Centre for Sericulture and Biological Pest management Centre, R.T.M.N.U, Nagpur (C.S.B.R) & Dr. Bhabha Lokshikshan santha's, K.Z.S. Science College, Bramhani-Kalmeshwar on Sunday 1st March 2020.

First technical session stared with the topic: 'Sericulture & its prospects' given by Dr. M.K. Rathod, Ex. Director, C.S.B.R, and R.T.M.N.U. He elucidated about economics in sericulture business and gave examples about profits achieved by various farmers who have taken sericulture as their side business.

Second technical session was conducted by Dr. Rahile, Associate professor, Department of Zoology, Science college Pauni, where he explained about 'Apiculture techniques: The Honey bees and pollination, a boon for farmers'. He quoted with examples how fruiting plants stared bearing sweet fruits when wooden bee hives (Apiculture) were incorporated in the farms. His presentation was full of success stories of farmers using apiculture in their farms. Beneficial products like honey, royal jelly, propolis, bee wax and bee venom extraction enhanced the vision of the farmers and motivated them to use bee hives.

Third technical session Dr. Vijay D. Raut, Assistant professor, Department of Zoology, Tai Golwalkar Mahavidyalaya Ramtek, described about 'Moriculture and nurturing Mulberry silkworm techniques'. Types of rearing of silkworm was well explained where farmers get an idea for non – laborious methods of feeding the silkworms for better cocoon results.

#### **Outcomes:**

Many farmers were benefitted by these sessions. Even there was an awareness created within students, teaching & non-teaching staff where they get a vision of motivation for famers of Vidarbha region who are bearing losses in their crops. They can definitely use these supporting small scale industries which would help them financially and stop farmer's suicidal attempts in Vidarbh region. 88 Farmers, 36 Students and 20 teachers attended the workshop.

# 7. MATADAN JANGAGRUTI


Objectives: The awareness program was organized on the occasion of MATADAN JANGAGRUTI on 15/10/2019 at

## 10. SPECIAL NSS CAMP


Aim: To organize the NSS camp to develop socially responsible citizens for community service and national development.

Aim: To organize the Vaccination camp at College.




## 9. National Girl child day

## 10. National Voters Day


Aim: To celebrate National Voters' Day.
