डॉ. होमी जहागीर भाभा यांचे स्मृतीस अभिवादन करून.....

भारतीय संस्कृतीत अनेक मानवतावादी, सुसंस्कृत माणसे तयार झाली. विधायक मनोवृत्ती असलेला एक कुशल इंजिनियर, प्रख्यात शास्त्रज्ञ कला प्रेमी व माणूस म्हणून, थोर विचारवंत म्हणून 'होमी जहागीर भाभा' यांचे नाव भारतात मोठ्या आदराने व प्रेमाने घेतले जाते. स्वतंत्र भारताला समर्थ व बलवान करण्यासाठी त्यांनी आपल्या जीवाचे रान केले. त्यांचा जन्म ३० ऑक्टोबर, १९०९ साली सधन पारशी कुटुंबात झाला. होमी भाभा भारतीय अणु भौतिकशास्त्रज्ञ होते. भारताच्या अणुउर्जा विकास कार्यक्रमाचा पाया रचण्याच्या कामगिरीमुळे त्यांना भारताच्या अणुउर्जा व अण्वस्त्र विकास कार्यक्रमाचे प्रणेता मानले जाते. वडील जहांगीर भाभा हे बॅरीस्टर होते. त्यांचे प्राथमिक ते पदवी पर्यंतचे शिक्षण मुंबई येथे झाले. होमी यांनी पुढे इंजिनियर व्हावे असे त्यांच्या वडिलांना वाटत होते. पण होमी यांनी वडिलांना आपल्या गणित आणि भौतिकशास्त्रातच विशेष आवडतात असे ठामपणे सांगितले. होमी भाभा केंब्रीज विद्यापिठातून इ.स. १९३० साली प्रथम श्रेणीत इंजिनियर झाले. तसेच पॉल डिरॅक यांच्या मार्गदर्शना खाली गणिताचा अभ्यासही करीत राहिले. त्या काळात त्यांना शिष्यवृत्ती आणि अनेक बक्षीसेही मिळाली. इ. स. १९४० साली भारतात परत आल्यावर काही काळ डॉ. भाभा यांनी भारतीय विज्ञान संस्था, बंगलोर येथे प्रोफेसर म्हणून काम केले. इ.स. १९४५ साली टाटा मूलभूत संशोधन संस्थेची स्थापना करण्यात मदत केली आणि आपले संशोधन कार्य संभाळून डॉ. भाभा टाटा मूलभूत संशोधन संस्थेचे संचालक झाले.

भारताच्या स्वातंत्र्यानंतर इ.स. १९४८ साली त्यांच्या पुढाकाराने अणुउर्जा आयोगाची स्थापना करण्यात आली. याही संस्थेचे तेच संचालक म्हणून काम पाहू लागले. त्यांच्या परिश्रमांमुळेच भारत देशात अणुभट्टीची स्थापना होऊ शकली. अणुचा वापर शांततेच्या मार्गानेच व्हावा असे ठाम मत संयुक्त राष्ट्रांच्या सभेत मांडणारे भाभा हे पहिले वैज्ञानिक. डॉ. भाभा यांनी पाया रचला म्हणूनच भारताने अनेक ठिकाणी अणुभट्टी सुरू करून त्यांच्या विजनिर्मितीसाठी उपयोग केला तसेच १८ मे, इ.स. १९६४ यादिवशी भारताने पोखरण येथे पहिला अणुस्फोट घडवून आणला. भारतात अणु पर्वाची सुरुवात करण्याच्या डॉ. भाभा यांना अणू क्षेत्रातील कामाबद्दल अँडम्स पारितोषिक, हॉपकिन्स पारितोषिक, पद्मभूषण इत्यादी अनेक पुरस्कार लाभले. भारतीय विज्ञान परिषदेचे अध्यक्षस्थान ही त्यांनी भूषविले. संयुक्त राष्ट्रांच्या सभेला जातांना २४ जानेवारी, इ.स. १९६६ यादिवशी फ्रान्सच्या हद्दीत असतांना त्यांचे विमान अपघातात निधन झाले. त्यांच्या मृत्युनंतर ट्रॉम्बे येथील अणू संशोधन केंद्राचे नाव बदलून भाभा अणू संशोधन केंद्र असे ठेवण्यात आले.

वैज्ञानिक क्षेत्रामध्ये डॉ. भाभा यांच्या अतुलनीय कार्याची प्रेरणा घेवून संस्थेने महाविद्यालयाचे बिजरोपण केले. वंचीत परंतु हुशार विद्यार्थ्यांचे शैक्षणिक स्वप्न पूर्ण करण्याच्या आमचा मानस आहे. या कार्यात समाजातील सर्व स्तरातील नागरीक, पालक, विद्यार्थी यांचा सहभाग व आशिर्वाद अपेक्षित आहे.

Duration of the Program, Student Progression Path and Provisions for Multiple Entry and Exit Duration of the B.Sc. Program with the provision for multiple exits as mentioned here:

Multiple Exit:

Students will have the flexibility to enter a program in odd semesters and exit a program after the successful completion of even semester as per their future career needs:

1. A student can exit the program after successful completion of semesters I & II having earned requisite number of credits as mentioned in the scheme of examination and additional 'NSQF* Course or Internship' with 4 credits. Such a student shall be eligible for the award of 'Certificate in Science' by the University. OR a student can continue the program in 2nd year.
2. A student can exit the program after successful completion of semesters I, II, III, & IV having earned requisite number of credits as mentioned in the scheme of examination and additional 'NSQF* Course or Internship' with 4 credits. Such a student shall be eligible for the award of 'Diploma in Science' by the University. OR a student can continue the program in 3rd year.
3. A student can exit the program after successful completion of semesters I, II, III, IV, V & VI having earned requisite number of credits as mentioned in the scheme of examination. Such a student shall be eligible for the award of 'Three Year Bachelor of Science' degree by the University.

Admission Rules

1. Admission process for B.Sc. Sem-I will be completed as per Govt. of Maharashtra. Circular No. G.B.C.-1996/183296/dated 02-06-1997 and Government resolution No.UGC,2003/(33/03)/2/Higher Edn-4 dated 17th April 2003.
2. At the time of B.Sc. Sem-I admission students have to fill up the University enrollment form.
3. Students passing from any university other than RTM Nagpur University will have to submit migration certificate and eligibility certificate.
4. Applicant must submit the following documents at the time of admission-
 - i) Original and Xerox copy of School/college leaving certificate.
 - ii) Original and Xerox copy of Marksheet.
 - iii) Attested Xerox copy of caste certificate.
5. Students have to submit EBC/PTC form and deposit necessary fees on the date notified.
If he/she fails to do so his/her claim for admission will be treated cancelled.
6. Principal's decision will be final on all matters relating to the admissions.
7. Student free ship is awarded to the SC, ST, NT, VJ students and to the children of service personals. The eligible students should submit their application forms within 30 days from the date of their admission to the college and obtain receipt.
8. Student free ship under the E.B.C. Scheme also given to the students (Income below Rs. 65000/-). For that student should have income certificate from competent authority of state Govt not below the rank of Tehsildar.
9. After getting admission, there are following schemes of scholarships also available. For that students should have eligible. I) National scholarship II) Govt. of India scholarship to the backward class students. III) Govt. open merit scholarship. IV) Scholarship to the children of freedom fighter. V) Scholarship to the pupils passing from Govt. public school.

General Discipline Rules

1. Students shall obey all orders of the Principal.
2. Students will have to behave respectfully with the Principal, Teaching and Non-teaching staff of the college. They will also have to behave politely with fellow students. Any sort of disobedience, improper conduct or indecent remarks is punishable.
3. Students are prohibited to carry mobile phones in the college campus.
4. Any change in the address of the student must be informed to the admission clerk.
5. Any complaints regarding college should be addressed to the Principal.
6. All notices will be displayed on the notice board. Students must see these notices daily.

Rules For Attendance

1. It is compulsory for every student to have minimum 75% attendance in theory and practical classes separately.
2. Students belonging to SC/ST/EBC etc. getting scholarship/free studentships are warned that their scholarship/free studentships entirely depend upon their regular attendance.
3. Students remaining absent from theory or practical classes will be charged by Rs. 2 /- per periods as a fine.
4. It is compulsory for every student to appear in various unit tests and common test.
5. Students remaining absent from these tests without prior permission of Principal will have to pay a fine Rs. 5 /- per paper.
6. It is compulsory for every student to be present in various NSS and sports activities and to appear in concerning department tests.
7. No incentive marks will be awarded if a student does not have required percentage of attendance.

Facilities Available

It has been a constant endeavor of the college management to provide best possible facilities to students. Some of the facilities available are as follows:

1. Sport Department:

College has vast playfields in the campus itself for various sports activities. College participates in Cricket, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Volley Ball, Hand Ball, Chess; Athletics etc in inter collegiate tournaments. Every year many of our students get selected in university teams.

2. National Service Scheme (NSS):

College has a very active NSS unit. Students (Boys and Girls) desirous of participating in NSS activities are advised to contact NSS, Co-ordinator after finalizing their admission. Our NSS unit arranges various social programs during the session. Students participating in NSS activity can get benefit of incentive marks.

3. Computer center and Computer literacy Program:

Our college has established a well-equipped computer center to spread computer literacy among our student's. All college students will compulsorily be given computer training in windows, MS-Word, MS- Excel, MS Power Point, Internet and Tally.

4. Laboratory:

There are separate well-equipped laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Computer Science.

5. Central Library Facility:

The college has a rich and spacious central library. More than 20,000 books on various subjects are available in our college library. There is a book bank facility in our college library from which needy students are given book after getting borrower ticket. Besides main central library, there are also departmental libraries in some departments.

6. Canteen:

Canteen facility will be available for students in the college premises.

7. Cycle/Motor cycle stand:

There is a cycle /motorcycle stand near the main entrance of the college. Students are advised to keep their vehicles parked in the stand after locking them properly. College takes no responsibility for loss or damage of vehicles parked in cycle /motorcycle stand.

8. Girls Hostel:

There is a hostel facility in the college premises for the girls which are from economically poor classes. There are 25 seats available and will be filled on first come first serve basis.

9. Indoor Stadium:

The huge Indoor stadium is available for the students to play the indoor games.

Students have to be present for the celebrations of national days like *Independent day* and *Republic day* organized by college.

2. ANNIVERSARIES

Birth and Death anniversaries of great leaders and personalities are organized in the college with full respect. Students have to be present and to take keen interest in the programs.

3. EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Various kinds of competitions like quiz, debate, elocution, essay writing, posters making and slogan competition etc. are arranged throughout the session. Students have to participate in these activities.

4. LECTURE SERIES

The college has established STUDY FORUMS of all subjects and under these forums renowned personalities are being invited from time to time to make students knowledgeable with new ideas and thoughts.

5. CO-CURRICULAR PROGRAMMES

1. Study Tours and Excursion:

Various departments in the college organize study tours and excursions to different places as per their academic requirements. Such tours help students to orient themselves to the practical needs of a workaday world and to develop their social skills. It also boosts their confidence and empowers their personalities. Besides, students also enjoy the fun and excitement of travel and adventure.

2. Student Support Services:

The college offers student support services through a range of advice, information and support services designed to enrich the student's experience. It has a vocational guidance and career counseling center that helps the student to choose the right career.

3. Student Cultural Activities:

Other than regular activities, there is a mega event of "Sneh Milan" in which number of students taking part in various activities. The college also provides ample opportunities for students to develop and show case their talents.

4. Women's Development Cell:

Women's Development Cell is an individual part of women's protection program which seeks to cater to the specific needs of girl students of the college. It aims to empower and enhance the personalities and skills of the girl students in such a way that they can boldly face the challenges of the future.

5. Computer Literacy Program:
